



LVDSA on slack

1. The LVDSA Slack workspace is dedicated to constructive organizing and planning of its committees and subcommittees, and general announcements and discourse on its #chapter-general channel.
2. Offensive and unconstructive language is banned. Slanderous and counterproductive attacks on any LVDSA member or ally is prohibited. Workspace members engaging in aforementioned language, determined by LVDSA's Steering Committee, will receive a first warning, and any subsequent use of language of similar nature will result in user ban.
3. The majority of digital internal discourse made by LVDSA committees and subcommittees should be facilitated on their respective Slack channels.
4. The LVDSA Slack workspace is managed by its Communications Committee.
5. Invitations or deletions to any workspace member will be made by the Communications Committee or a Slack workspace admin.
6. Any channel deletion or creation will be suggested to and made by the Communications Committee.
7. All users on the LVDSA workspace must be DSA dues-paying members.
8. No spamming of either non-LVDSA related content or any sort of repetitive, unnecessary content.
9. Workspace members should have their Slack notifications, for both direct messages and channel messages, turned ON!
10. Keep things private! Refrain from taking screenshots of conversations in private channels or direct messages, with the intention of spreading confidential or private information, without the knowledge of parties involved in the initial conversation. Violation of this rule may lead to user ban determined by the Steering Committee.
